



# 2 KLR 0HGLFDO 0DULMXDQD & RQWURO 3URJUU :KROHD\ 8QLW 3ROLF\ 8SGDWH

[Rule 3796:8-2-04](#) of the Ohio Administrative Code defines the increments in which medical marijuana products can be sold in Ohio Medical Marijuana Control Program dispensaries. The rule states:

Under the previous interpretation of the rule, no products amounting to less than the whole-day unit could be sold at a dispensary. However, after collaboration between stakeholders and the State of Ohio Board of Pharmacy, the interpretation of the rule is as follows:

- x "Up to" language only applies to products containing less than the minimum increment of processed products
- x Patients can now purchase products with high CBD content and low THC content in more reasonable quantities
- x THC and CBD target doses continue to be required on product labels
- x Actual cannabinoid dose must still fall within ± 5% of target dose
- x Plant material is not impacted
