

Patient Responsibilities

Yes

Registered patients may purchase medical marijuana from any licensed dispensary in Ohio.

Yes

Patients and their caregivers may purchase any authorized form or combination of authorized forms, up to possession limits.

No

Patients and caregivers may not cultivate or extract medical marijuana.

No

The smoking of medical marijuana is not authorized. Ohio law only allows for oils, tinctures, plant material, edibles, patches, lotions, creams & ointments. Ohio law does allow vaping.

Yes

All patients, including minors, are required to have a government-issued photo identification to be used as part of the registry. The same identification will need to be presented at the dispensary.

Storage Requirements

Medical marijuana must be stored securely to prevent theft and unauthorized access.

Product must be stored in the dispensary container with original label.

Registration Requirements

A patient or caregiver registration will be valid from the date of first issuance and expire one year later, on the last day of the month it was issued. If the patient is diagnosed as terminally ill, the patient's registration will expire after six months.

The patient and caregiver registry is not publicly available.
